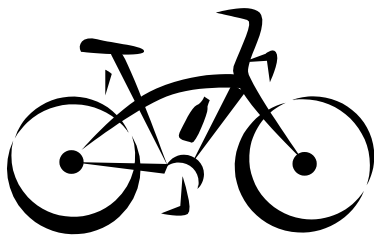

- Up to 13 Mile Cruiser Ride with 2 options for shorter courses (4.5 or 9 mile options).
- Family friendly casual ride for all skill levels.
- The ride passes 17 Pueblo Style Mexican Restaurants across town!
- Built in stops for chances to taste local cuisine and drinks (bring cash or credit card to buy what you like).
- Explore Pueblo's New Bicycle Lanes on Greenwood St. and Elizabeth St.

- **11 am:** Main St. parking lot by police station - Main St. and D St.
- **11:15 am:** Safety briefing and ride starts.
- **11:15 am - 1 pm:** *Mesa Junction & Bessemer* 4.5 mile loop—past Mexi-Deli, Taco Stop, Klamm's Shell, El Alamo, Aunty Bev's, Mill Stop, El Nopal, Jorge's Sombrero, Jorge's Mercado & Delicias Tamales Y Taquerias. Includes Lunch Break for Taco Stop—pick your favorite place and meet back to continue ride.
- **1 pm - 2 pm:** *Historic Union Avenue to East Side* past Papa Jose's and Rita's with a short drink stop at Vasquez or Taco Stop. (About 9 miles total).
- **2 pm - 4 pm:** Continue on entire 13.34 mile ride through *Historic North Side* and play on new bike lanes past Burrito's Betty. Quick loop around Mineral Palace Park ending at Mexican food options downtown including Nacho's or Rojas as options. **Visit your favorite!**
